

Middle School (6th – 8th Grade) Supply List 2024-2025

Students have *two options* for binder organization:

1. Each class in separate binders

- (7) 3-ring binders (1-inch size) with
- (4) plastic pocket dividers in each:
 - S.S./Religion: 2 red binders
 - English/Literature: 2 white binders
 - Math/Science: 2 green binders
 - Special Area: 1 blue binder

2. Classes in the same time block grouped together in a binder

- (3) 3-ring binders (2-inch size) with
- (8) plastic pocket dividers in each:
 - Social Studies/Religion: red binder
 - English/Literature: white binder
 - Math/Science: green binder
- (1) 3-ring binder (1-inch size) with (4) plastic pocket dividers:
 - Special Area: 1 blue binder

(5) Composition notebooks:

- Spanish/Latin
- Math
- Science
- Religion (6th graders and new students only)

(2) Notebooks, spiral bound

- English
- Religion

(1) Headphones - For use with multiple classes (no earbuds). Examples:

- Elecder i37 headphones
- Koss KPH7

(1) Locker Shelf - 6th Graders and New Students must buy a 12 inch locker shelf that will be kept for all three years.
